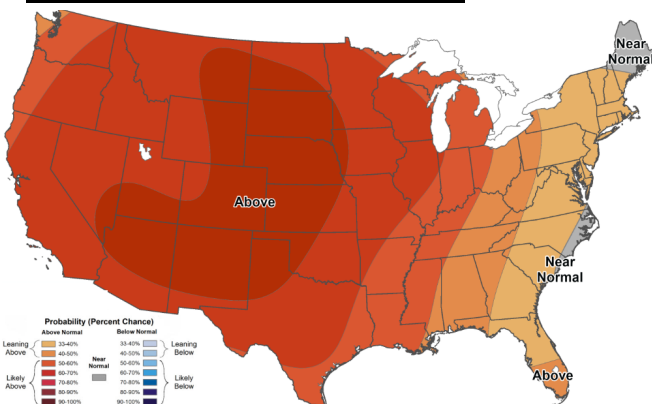
Near-Month Natural Gas

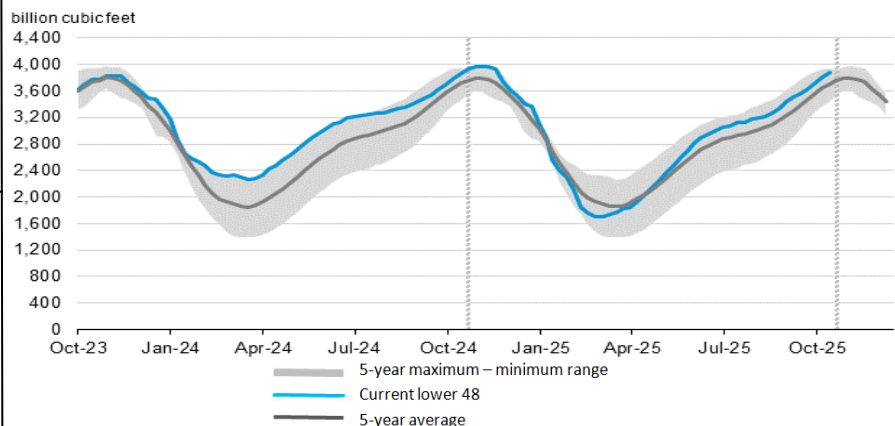
For the week ending Oct 24, 2025, natural gas storage reported by the Energy Information Administration (EIA) was as follows:
